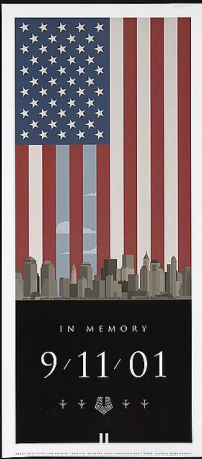

**SEPTEMBER 11, PATIROT DAY REMEMBERING THE 2,977 WHO LOST THEIR LIVES-
25th Anniversary of the 9/11 attacks-**

- **Flags at Half-Staff:** U.S. flags are flown at half-staff on the White House, all federal buildings, and individual homes.
- **Moment of Silence:** A nationwide moment of silence is observed, typically starting at 8:46 AM (EDT), the moment the first plane struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center.

- **Founder:** Marian McQuade campaigned during the 1970s to honor senior citizens and connect generations.
- **Official Recognition:** President Jimmy Carter signed the official presidential proclamation in 1978.
- **Official Flower:** The forget-me-not.
